The Association Virgo Vox INVITES composers from all nationalities, ages, ethnic orientations and compositional styles to the

COMPOSITION OF CHORAL SONGS FOR FEMALE ENSEMBLE

The main purpose of the Workshop is to encourage creativity in the music field and the composition of new songs, especially for female groups

PIECES

Composed for female ensemble (i.e. choral groups consisting of between 5 and 10 members)

Preferably be a cappella (however, songs with accompaniment of a small instrumental group will also be evaluated)

Maximum subdivision of 8 voices

Duration between 3 and 10 minutes

Spanish, Latin, it will also be necessary to send a phonetic transcription of the text. Open themes can be interpreted freely as regards the choice of both texts and genre (sacred or profane). Each composer will be allowed to present a maximum of **three** pieces.

The pieces that do not meet the theme requirements will be excluded from the competition and may be re-presented in other editions within the necessary requirements.

The music sheet must contain the title of the piece and the lyricist and/or its source.

The composer's name must NOT appear in the sheet music.

The songs will be presented to the commission anonymously.

There is a fee of €20 for the first piece and €10 for the second and third. The top 5 finalists will be notified by email by **20 September 2021** and will be invited to discuss their compositions with the jury. The meeting, either in person or by video call, will take place by **30 September 2021**.

There will be a maximum of 3 winning compositions. The official notification of the selected pieces will appear on the www.virgovox.it website.

The composers of the selected pieces will have the opportunity to attend and record their composition at an open rehearsal.

The winners of the competition will be asked the open file FINALE.

Some pieces may be included in the repertoire of the ensemble at the discretion of the artistic director.
